The articles submitted should not be in the process of being evaluated nor have publishing commitments with any other publication. All articles submitted to LAR in its calls for papers undergo a plagiarism detection process. When partial (i.e., without the corresponding citation) or total plagiarism is detected, the text will not be considered for evaluation and the authors will be notified of the reason for rejection.

Papers submitted for evaluation must strictly comply with the rules set by Latin American Law Review (see: <https://revistas.uniandes.edu.co/for-authors/lar/editorial-policy>)
